Regardless of the source of funding, all students employed as Graduate Research Assistants will be provided with tuition remission and will be offered the Graduate Assistant Health Benefit.

Proposals will be reviewed to ensure that tuition and health insurance costs are included in the budget for any proposed GRAs. If health insurance is not included due to sponsor or other restrictions, OSP will require written confirmation from the department that, should the proposal be funded, it will provide funding for health insurance for any GRA electing to be covered by the University sponsored health insurance plan.
